

## **D. EDWARD GREENE**



Edward Greene is a Director in the credit risk management division of Freddie Mac, located in McLean, VA. In his current capacity he is responsible for providing risk management advisory services for the world's second largest multifamily loan portfolio. Prior to joining Freddie Mac, Mr. Greene was a Managing Director and Deputy Chief Underwriter with Greystone Servicing Corp., a financial services and trading company, located in Bethesda, MD. Prior to joining Greystone Servicing Corp., Mr. Greene was a Vice President with Red Capital Group, Inc., a financial services company engaged in real estate investment, merchant, and mortgage banking located in Reston, VA.
